TASTING NOTES A wine of balanced opulence with rich aromatics of red cherry, baking spices and earthy forest floor notes. A fresh, laser focused wine with black current, raspberry and dark cherry layers along the palate culminating in a long, elegant finish.

GROWING SEASON The 2021 Sonoma Coast vintage is marked as having exceptionally high quality for both red and white varieties. The 2021 Pinot Noir budbreak and bloom were similar to the 2020 season, both taking place slightly later than the five-year average. Veraison and harvest were within a few days of our five-year average with no heat spikes during the growing season. The long, mild growing season allowed for extended hang time and exceptional flavor development.

VINEYARD SELECTIONS

Sourced from block 212 of our Pastoral Vineyard on the western Sonoma Coast: 50% clone Swan and 50% Calera clone.

BARREL AGING

The wine was aged for fifteen months in 50% new French oak and 50% used French oak barrels before bottling.
