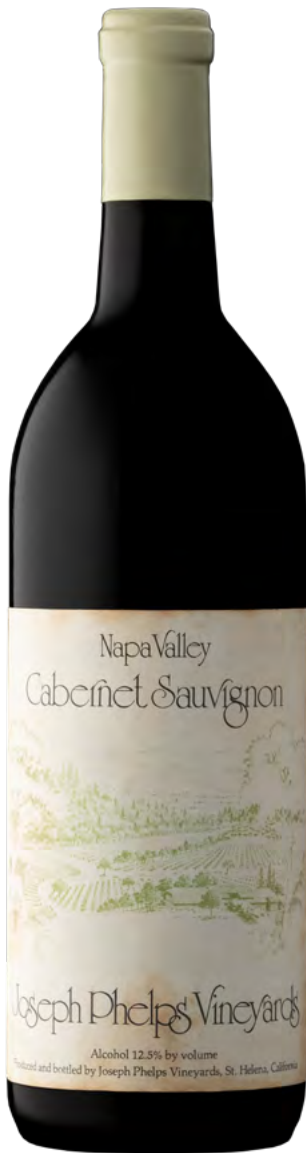

ORIGINAL NOTES In 1981 before the live television cameras of NBC, a prestigious blind tasting was held in London with 10 California Cabernets and 10 Bordeaux, and the Phelps' 1977 came in second. The concentrated ripe berry and mint-like flavors were intriguing then and are even more delicious now. This wine has always generated a lot of interest and is one of the stand-outs of the vintage.

BARREL AGING
