

## Cabernet Sauvignon

## 1979 Vintage

ORIGINAL NOTES This year's Cabernet Sauvignon component is a blend of grapes grown on the eastern side of the valley floor near Oakville, together with the first significant crop from vines on our home ranch in St. Helena. The relatively high Merlot addition has served to make the wine appreciably more forward at this stage, and indeed it drinks well now. The aroma is a combination of green olive and mint, the flavors appropriately fruity, and the finish soft and appealing.

BARREL AGING

The wine was aged for twenty-four months in I00% French oak barrels before bottling.
