ORIGINAL NOTES The I990 growing season was characterized by warm days and unusually cool nights, providing optimum conditions for photosynthesis and grape maturation. Fruit ripened slowly and steadily, and from a production standpoint the pace of the harvest probably contributed as much to the overall quality of the vintage as the near-perfect condition of the grapes. This wine contains the classic structure, balance, and rich fruit flavors we would expect of a Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon from an excellent vintage.

BARREL AGING
